Education for All

So far, we have sent children of the minority (the Mangyan tribe) to school, held literacy classes in places too remote for their children to go to school, and planned livelihood projects to help the people stand on their own. Education is a very basic need. We certainly can live without education, but without education, we cannot make true decisions of our own. Uneducated people are easy to control.

4 years ago, we sent an agriculturist to a very remote village, and started teaching agriculture, as part of our education program. In the beginning, this never seemed to work; ag-

riculture was something foreign to the very primitive people who were used to collect food from the forest, which is now almost extinct because of illegal logging. But, with the great effort and dedication of our agriculturist, little by little, the people started to imitate him. Within 3 years they were producing rice and vegetables, and seemed less starving. All other villages were amazed at the development, and one after another, came to us to ask for help. Now, we are planning an "Agriculture School Complex" where we can keep the children in the dormitory so that they can go to school in town, where people can come and study agriculture as well as raise food for the children in the dormitory, and act as the center of our operation in the area.
